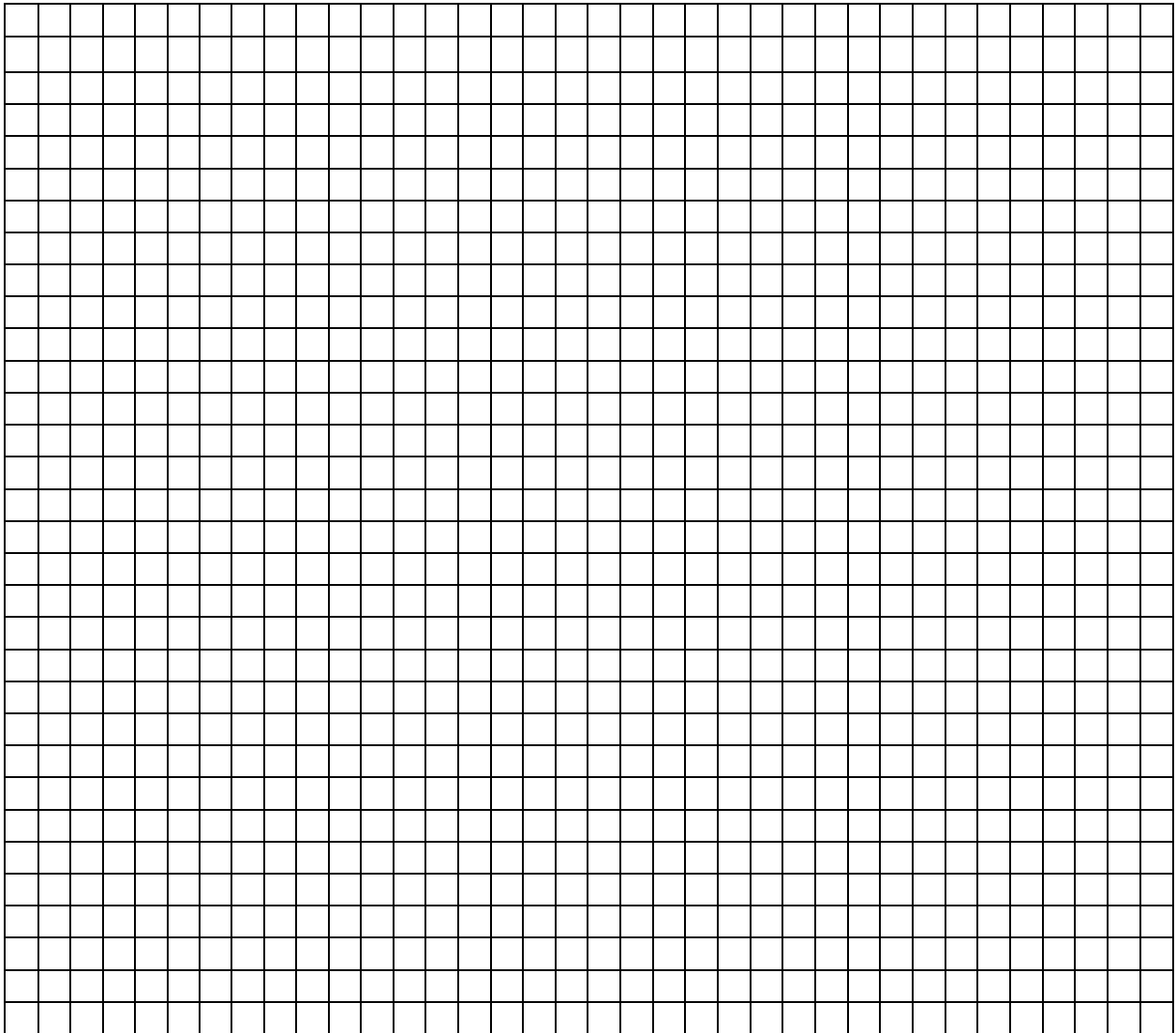

SITE PLAN

1. Indicate North point and abutting roads.
2. Show locations of all structures and driveways; indicate if new or existing.
3. Show dimensions of proposed structures and other development, expressed in feet.
4. Show off-street parking and loading areas (if any), with dimensions.
5. Show location of well and septic including tank and drain field (if applicable).
6. The property owner is responsible and liable for exact measurements from all lot lines and easements. Check with the City Inspector if you have any questions.
7. Designated FEMA flood areas require a flood plain development permit which includes additional restrictions.
8. Application and drawings must be completed and returned with the permit fee, before it will be processed and approved/denied.
