Moville City Council Budget Meeting Monday, January 20, 2024

Hayworth motioned to approve agenda, seconded by Rapp. Ayes, motion carries. Hayworth motions to approve last meeting minutes, seconded by Hayworth. Ayes, motion carries. Stee Maxwell speaks at open forum and informs the Council that MCDAI looking into a possible Daycare/Childcare Facility utilizing the Methodist Church Sunday school wing with the guidance and suggestions from representatives of the Crittenton Center. MCDAI will apply for grants to assist.

Council reviews 2025-2026 Department Budgets for Parks, Pool, Water, Wastewater, Streets /Road Use. No action taken on the approval of the 2025-26 budget at this time?

The Council Consensus was not to raise property taxes and a discussion will be made at the February Council meeting regarding water rate increases this July 2025 to offset the cost of the Water Improvement Project and water tower.

Out of the Parks Department budget the Council consensus is to make improvements to City owned MYRA buildings like fixing the roof of the soccer field concession stand.

Mayor Linden announces the business property at 220 Main Street was selected by an external group for the Community Catalyst Grant to renovate the existing structure which will generate more needed business for our community to continue thriving! Mayor and Council concerns and comments were discussed.
